# YEAR IN REVIEW

## A Letter From the Chief Volunteer Officer and President and CEO

Dear YMCA Friends,

**OUR SHARED PURPOSE:** At the YMCA of the Virginia Peninsulas, our purpose is clear and enduring: to nurture the potential of every child and teen, promote healthy living, and foster a sense of social responsibility so that everyone—regardless of age, income, or background—has the opportunity to thrive. In 2025, that purpose came to life in meaningful and measurable ways across our communities.

This past year was defined by momentum, partnership, and impact. Together—with the dedication of our staff, the generosity of our donors, the leadership of our volunteers, and the trust of our members—we strengthened the foundation of our YMCA and expanded our ability to serve families throughout the Virginia Peninsulas.

**OUR PEOPLE:** At the heart of our YMCA are people. Our staff bring passion, professionalism, and care to their work every day, creating welcoming environments where individuals and families feel supported and inspired. Our volunteers lead with generosity and purpose, giving their time and talents to advance our mission. Our donors and community partners invest in a shared vision of stronger, healthier communities. And our members inspire us by showing up—for themselves, their families, and one another.

Together, this collective commitment fuels everything we do and makes the YMCA a trusted and essential community partner.

**OUR PROGRAMS:** Youth development remained central to our work in 2025. From early childhood education to before- and after-school care, summer camps, and teen leadership programs, the YMCA provided safe, welcoming spaces where young people could learn, grow, and build confidence. We celebrated the opening of the Mathews Family YMCA Preschool, expanding access to high-quality early learning, and advanced new school-age childcare partnerships that will serve families across Gloucester County.

Our commitment to teens continued through leadership programs that empower young people to find their voice, develop responsibility, and engage in civic life. Programs such as Leaders Club and Youth & Government helped shape confident, capable future leaders.

In a region defined by water, safety remained a critical priority. Through our Second Grade Learn to Swim initiative and Safety Around Water programs, thousands of children and families gained lifesaving skills in 2025. A signature partnership with Busch Gardens Williamsburg and Water Country USA expanded the reach and visibility of this work, reinforcing the YMCA's role as a regional leader in water safety.

Beyond the pool, we supported health and well-being in spirit, mind, and body—offering fitness, wellness, and outreach programs that remove barriers and help people of all ages live healthier, more connected lives.

**OUR PLACES:** Our YMCA facilities are more than buildings; they are community hubs where families gather, relationships are built, and support is always within reach. In 2025, we continued to invest in and strengthen these spaces so they can serve our region for generations to come.

Through the Building Our Future capital initiative, we advanced key projects at Victory YMCA, Camp Kekoka, and the Northumberland DynaDome. We also took meaningful steps toward bringing a new YMCA to Surry County, extending our mission to a growing community and reinforcing our long-term commitment to access, belonging, and impact.

As we look ahead, we do so with optimism and renewed focus as we launch Shaping Our Future – Impact 2030, our new strategic plan to guide the next chapter of our YMCA's work. Building on the momentum of 2025, this plan affirms our commitment to deepen our impact, strengthen our communities, and ensure the YMCA remains a vital, trusted partner for generations to come. Thank you for believing in the YMCA of the Virginia Peninsulas and for being part of this important work.

In 2023, **Kathy** was diagnosed with cancer and underwent surgery to remove two tumors from her frontal lobe—one the size of a clementine and another the size of a lemon—followed by 15 days of radiation. Throughout her recovery, exercise became her lifeline. Even on her hardest days, when taking a single step felt impossible, Kathy showed up for her classes at the Y. Her classmates rallied around her—helping her set up, offering encouragement, and forming lasting friendships. Today, Kathy credits her Y family for their constant support and check-ins, and for helping her stay strong, hopeful, and active through her journey.

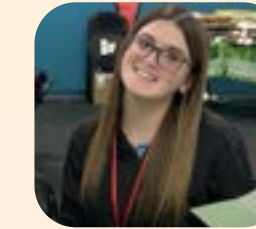

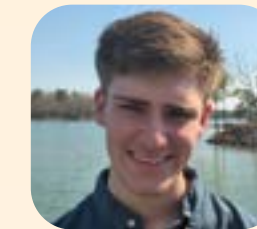

These distinguished volunteers have given generously of their time, talent, and passion, helping to guide the YMCA through periods of growth, change, and enduring community impact. **This year, we are proud to recognize two exceptionally dedicated, long-time volunteers whose leadership and service exemplify the very best of the YMCA's mission and values.** Though their terms of board service have concluded, their influence continues, through the programs, facilities, and lives strengthened by their leadership—and they remain valued ambassadors and champions of the Y.



### Rob Brown, Sr.

With more than 24 years of extraordinary service, Rob Brown, Sr. has been a driving force in shaping the YMCA's leadership, growth, and long-term impact. Since joining the Association Board of Directors in 1998, Rob has generously shared his time, expertise, and passion through numerous leadership roles, including Vice Chair (2002–2003) and Chief Volunteer Officer (2004–2005). His legacy is perhaps most powerfully reflected in more than two decades of leadership with the Capital Task Force—later the Capital Development Committee, where his vision and steady guidance helped bring transformational facility projects and strategic growth initiatives to life for generations of YMCA members.



### Tom Morris, Jr.

A truly dedicated servant-leader, Tom Morris, Jr. has devoted more than 30 years to advancing the mission of the YMCA through exceptional volunteer leadership. He began his YMCA journey in the early 1990s as a member of the Hampton Family YMCA Advisory Board, where his commitment to community impact and strong governance first took shape. Tom later served as Board Chair of the Hampton Family YMCA in 1995 before joining the Association Board of Directors in 1996. He quickly stepped into executive leadership roles as Vice Chair (1997) and Chief Volunteer Officer (1998–1999). Throughout his remarkable tenure, Tom has been a trusted leader across many vital committees, including Capital Development, Endowment, and Board Governance—leaving a lasting legacy through his wisdom, dedication, and unwavering belief in the Y's mission.

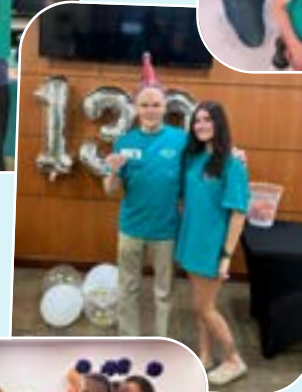

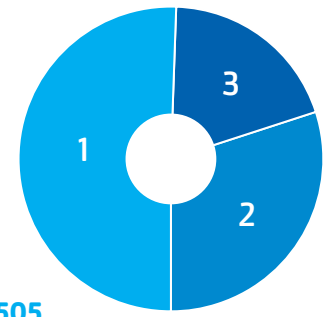

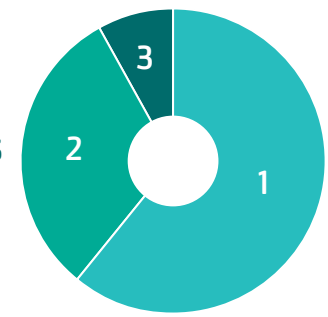
